Day 1

Saturday 16th January

The tour started with an overnight flight from the UK to Nepal via Doha

Day 2

Sunday 17th January

Group members arrived at Kathmandu airport where they met Suchit and transferred to the Hotel Yak & Yeti. The rest of the day was spent at leisure

Day 3

Monday 18th January

After breakfast we returned to the airport for our flight to Bir. We then drove to Koshi Camp where we had lunch and spent the afternoon birding in the vicinity of the camp.

Day 4

Tuesday 19th January

Today the weather was overcast with light mist. After breakfast we visited the south end of the reserve. We returned to camp for lunch and in the afternoon visited the north end.

Day 5

Wednesday 20th January

It was misty and overcast again. After breakfast we set off and drove to Jabdi where we boarded a boat for a trip on the River Koshi. We ate our packed lunch on the boat. In the afternoon we returned to camp and spent the evening in a hide till it was dark.

Day 6

Thursday 21st January

Overnight rain cleared by 9am allowing us to bird the northern end of the reserve in the morning. We returned to camp for lunch and then had an afternoon drive to the south end.

Day 7

Friday 22nd January

Today was a travelling day and we left camp after breakfast with a packed lunch. Our morning flight was delayed, and in the afternoon we suffered more delays due to roadworks between Muglin and Nrayangath. We reached Tigerland at 9pm and had dinner before retiring to bed.

Day 8

Saturday 23rd January

The weather was better today. The sun came out at 10.30am and we enjoyed blue skies till the evening. After breakfast at 7.30am we went on a three and a half hour walk. We were collected by transport at the end of the walk and returned to our lodge for lunch.

In the afternoon we went on a two-hour Elephant safari.

Day 9**Sunday 24th January**

After breakfast we took a packed lunch and then spent the whole day on a jungle safari, exploring the western end of Chitwan National Park by Jeep. We had sun in the afternoon but it was a little chilly driving back.

Day 10**Monday 25th January**

After breakfast we were taken to a bridge over the River Rapti from where we had a birding walk to a boat area. We then boarded a boat and floated down the River Rapti for about 40 minutes before landing.

We were collected by vehicle and returned to the lodge where we had lunch. Later we went on another jeep safari.

Day 11**Tuesday 26th January**

Today was another travelling day and after breakfast we left Chitwan at 7am with a packed lunch. We made a number of stops en route and arrived at Bardia at 5pm.

Day 12**Wednesday 27th January**

Today there was light mist in the morning but it was a pleasant afternoon and evening. We enjoyed both morning and afternoon Jeep safaris.

Day 13**Thursday 28th January**

We had another morning and afternoon Jeep safari today and the weather was similar to the day before.

Day 14**Friday 29th January**

Again we enjoyed both morning and afternoon Jeep safaris today.

Day 15**Saturday 30th January**

We left at 9am after breakfast for the short journey to Suklaphanta. We had a biding stop at Ghodaghodi Lake and reached Suklaphanta Wildlife Camp about 2.30pm. At the River Mahakali we saw one of the world's ten longest suspension bridges.

Day 16**Sunday 31st January**

Today we took a packed lunch and spent the full day exploring Suklaphanta Wildlife Reserve in two Jeeps.

Day 17**Monday 1st February**

The weather was cold with light mist till around 11am, and then it was pleasant afterwards. In the morning we had a Jeep safari, returning to camp for a hot lunch before our afternoon safari.

Day 18**Tuesday 2nd February**

The weather was similar to yesterday, but today we took a packed lunch and spent a full day exploring Suklaphanta Wildlife Reserve in two Jeeps.

Day 19**Wednesday 3rd February**

We had an easy morning birding around the camp premises and visiting the adjacent local area. We left at 10.30am for Dhangadi airport for our flight to Kathmandu, enjoying excellent views of the Himalayas.

Day 20**Thursday 4th February**

After breakfast we left with a packed lunch in two four-wheel drive vehicles and visited Phulchowki Hill. We stayed till 2.30pm before returning to the hotel.

Day 21/22**Friday 5th/Saturday 6th February**

After some free time in Kathmandu we returned to the airport for our flights home. We again flew overnight via Doha, and once back at Heathrow airport another Naturetrek adventure came to an end.
