## Day 1

**Sunday 11 February**

Arrival in Kathmandu and transfer to Hotel Marsyangdi. Afternoon slight drizzle.

## Day 2

**Monday 12 February**

Fly to Biratnagar. Excellent views of Mt Everest and other Himalayan ranges. Drive 1 and half hours from Biratnagar to Koshi Tappu. Afternoon bird watching north of Koshi Camp for a couple of hours. Overnight in Koshi Camp.

## Day 3

**Tuesday 13 February**

Last night rained with thunder and lightening. Record breaking rain in Kathmandu and in the entire country - Kathmandu Valley Floor experienced snow after 61 years!

It was raining for a long time however we took our chance to visit Koshi Barrage in two land rovers. Hot lunch at the camp after our return. Afternoon birding north of the Koshi Tappu Reserve.

## Day 4

**Wednesday 14 February**

Early breakfast followed by drive to Rajabas for boating. Boating all the way down to Titrigaachhi in Koshi Tappu Reserve. Boating covered nearly 15kms. Packed lunch by the bank of Koshi River. After boating 2 hours walk along the bund for birdwatching. Drive back to Camp.

## Day 5

**Thursday 15 February**

Had an early breakfast and set off driving to Chitwan along the east west Highway. Lunch just before reaching Hetauda, close to a stream. At least 3 stops for Ibisbills along the Rapti River but none located. It was a sunny clear day throughout. Had rained at Chitwan prior to our arrival. Overnight in Machan Paradise Resort.

**Day 6****Friday 16 February**

Today we had tea early and started an early morning elephant safari. We came back and had breakfast at 9:15hrs. We went birding along the river bank until the lunch time. We drove in a landrover after the lunch until the evening. Overnight in Machan Paradise Resort.

**Day 7****Saturday 17 February**

We got up early and had early breakfast and drove heading to Kathmandu following the beautiful Trishuli River. On the way stopped at several places. Highlights were 4 species of Forktails and 4 Ibisbills. We had a packed lunch watching Ibisbills. Overnight in Hotel Marsyangdi.

**Day 8****Sunday 18 February**

Started early. Most clients departed for London. Four clients had extended their stay to Phulchoki. Due to snow almost all the way to the house, it was not possible to go up. Huge influx of local teens to see snow hindered birdwatching! Overnight in Hotel.

**Day 9****Monday 19 February**

Whole day birding at Phulchoki hill, overnight at Marsyangdi.

**Day 10****Tuesday 20 February**

Whole day birding at Phulchoki hill, overnight at Marsyangdi. Final Departure for those on the extension.
