Day 1

Thursday 10th January

Our overnight flight to Entebbe, via Nairobi, departed from Heathrow in the early evening.

Day 2

Friday 11th January

Entebbe

The group arrived at Entebbe International Airport at 09:20hrs. and after clearing immigration and collecting their bags, they were welcomed by Jude and we then proceeded to 2 Friends Resort Hotel where there was time to rest and relax after a long journey. Later in the afternoon we went birding in the Botanical Gardens where we were able to see a number of bird species including the Great Blue Turaco, Woodland Kingfisher, Ross's Turaco, Double-toothed Barbet, Eastern Grey Plantain-eater, Hooded Vulture, Black and White casqued Hornbill, Hammerkop, Fork-tailed Drongo, Red-chested Sunbird, Little Greenbul, Pied Kingfisher, Orange Weaver, Village Weaver, Speckled Mousebird and Hadada Ibis, among others. Not only birds were seen, but also several mammals including Guezera Colobus Monkeys, Vervet Monkey, Red-tailed Monkey, Side-striped Ground Squirrel and so on. We spent the night at 2 Friends Resort Beach Hotel.

Day 3

Saturday 12th January

Mabamba Swamp and Lake Mburu National Park

After breakfast, we collected our bags, boarded the vehicle and headed to Mabamba Swamp, famously known for the rare Shoebill Stork – one of the most sought-after birds on this tour. Upon reaching the swamp, we boarded our local canoes and luckily enough, we saw the Shoebill after about 45minutes of searching at around 09:30am. We were able to photograph this impressive rare bird at a reasonable distance of about 15-20 metres.

Other bird species spotted while at the swamp included Malachite Kingfisher, African Jacana, Pied Kingfisher, Long-crested Eagle, Northern Brown-throated Weaver, Yellow-billed Duck, Whistling Cisticola, Blue-breasted Bee-eater, Fan-tailed Widowbird, Long-toed Lapwing, White-winged Tern, Cattle Egret, Little Egret and so on. Later in mid-morning we left and headed to Lake Mburu National Park where we spent two nights staying at the Rwakobo Rock Lodge exploring this beautiful park.

Day 4

Sunday 13th January

Lake Mburu National Park

While at Lake Mburu, we were able to see many bird and mammal species. Birds included African Fish Eagle, African Finfoot, Giant Kingfisher, Hammerkop, Blue-naped Mousebird, Pied Crow, Lilac-breasted Roller, Green Wood-hoopoe, Crested Francolin, White-browed Coucal, Black-headed Gonolek, Yellow White-eye, White-winged Warbler, Yellow-billed Stork, Black-shouldered Kite, Lizard Buzzard, Fork-tailed Drongo among others.

Mammal sightings in Lake Mburo were also very impressive, including Giraffe, Topi, Buffalo, Deffasa, Waterbuck, Impala, Eland, Common Warthog, Bushbuck, Olive Baboon, Vervet Monkey, Dwarf Mongoose and Banded Mongoose.

After enjoying Lake Mburo for two nights, we continued further, heading south towards Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park where we spent three nights at the amazing Mahogany Springs Lodge. On our way to Bwindi, we had a couple of stops for birding and we saw a lot of species including the Western Banded Snake Eagle, Woolly-necked Stork, Long Crested Eagle, Little Bee-eater, Little Swift, Black-headed Heron, Grey-crowned Crane, Open-billed Stork, Grey-backed Fiscal, Black-headed Batis, Grey-headed Sparrows, African Paradise Flycatcher, Common Fiscal, Ross's Turaco, Double-toothed Barbet, White-throated Bee-eater, Common Bulbul, Pied Wagtail, Cattle Egret and so on.

Day 5 - 7

Monday 14th – Wednesday 16th January

Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park

On our first day in Bwindi Geraldine went on the Gorilla Trek and the rest of the team went out for leisurely bird watching in the forest where a number of bird species were sighted. These include the Bronze Sunbird, Yellow-rumped Tinkerbird, Great Blue Turaco, Tambourine Dove, Common Bulbul, Black-billed Weaver, Little Greenbul, Petit's Cuckooshrike, Buff-throated Apalis, Golden-breasted Bunting, Black Saw-wing, Pink-footed Puffback, and so on.

We had another day bird watching in Bwindi and we all agreed to walk up to the waterfalls. On our way back from the waterfalls we unexpectedly encountered three Mountain Gorillas, giving everyone a chance to see this endangered species at no extra cost! Among the birds we sighted were the Cape Wagtail, Red-eyed Dove, Yellow White-eye, Common Bulbul, African Pied Wagtail, Speckled Mousebird, Black-headed Heron and Grey Parrot. We also saw a number of primates while in Bwindi forest such as the Blue Monkey, Black-and-White Colobus Monkey, Red-tailed Monkey, and L'Hoest's Monkey, plus Red-legged Sun Squirrel.

Day 8 - 10

Thursday 17th – Saturday 19th January

Queen Elizabeth National Park

We transferred from Bwindi to Queen Elizabeth National Park via the Ishasha sector, which is famous for its rare tree climbing Lions. We did a game drive in Ishasha which was actually a mixture of both game viewing and bird watching and we were very lucky to see a male Lion up a tree. We also saw Topi, Uganda Kob, Buffalo, Elephant, Bushbuck, Warthog, Deffasa, Waterbuck, troops of Olive Baboon and Vervet Monkey, Hippopotamus, Hooded Vulture, White-backed Vulture, Blue-spotted Wood Dove, Red-necked Francolin, Black Bee-eater, Sooty Chat, Blue-naped Mousebird, Nubian Woodpecker, Long-crested Eagle and Western Banded Snake Eagle.

We stayed at Park View Safari Lodge for the three nights, giving us time to enjoy the park. During our stay in Q.E.N.P. we encountered plenty of both mammals and birds. Once again we saw Lions – a male and a Lioness mating – plus Buffalos, Kobs, Banded Mongoose, Bushbuck, Black-billed Bustard, Saddle-billed Stork, Black-headed Gonolek, Black-chested Snake Eagle, Temminck's Courser, Flappet Lark, Hammerkop, Rufous-naped

Lark, Grassland Pipit, Senegal Lapwing, African Wattled Lapwing, Crowned Lapwing, Black-chinned Quail-Finch and Speckled Mousebird.

We took a boat cruise along the Kazinga channel and a number of birds were seen such as Ruff, Yellow-billed Stork, African Spoonbill, Marsh Sandpiper, Marabou Stork, Little Stint, Pied Kingfisher, Little Bee-eater, Lesser Striped Swallow, Slender-billed Weaver, Malachite Kingfisher, Red-chested Sunbird, Swamp Flycatcher, Grey Headed Sparrow and African Fish Eagle among others, and we also found a Nile Monitor Lizard.

Day 11/12

Sunday 20th/ Monday 21st January

Kibale Forest National Park

We left Park View and headed to Kibale Forest National Park with stops for birding en route, seeing, amongst others, Palm Nut Vulture, Grey-crowned Crane, Yellow-throated Longclaw, Village Weaver, Hadada Ibis, Lizard Buzzard, Black-winged Kite, White-browed Robin Chat, Ross's Turaco and Eastern Grey Plantain Eater. Finally, we reached Kibale National Park late in the evening, with the whole group eagerly looking forward to tomorrow's encounter with the Chimpanzees. We spent two nights at Primates Lodge.

On the day for the Chimpanzee trek everyone was in good spirits and of course excited to go and encounter these primates, which are of course our closest cousins.

After an early breakfast at Primates Lodge, we walked down to Kibale's visitor information centre for a briefing about the do's and the don'ts while with the Chimpanzees. At around 9:00am, the group headed into the forest in search of the Chimpanzees. It was a successful chimpanzee trekking experience for all the clients who returned very excited. We headed back to the Lodge for a hot lunch.

After lunch, later in the afternoon, we went out again for another walk in Bigodi swamp. The swamp is the extension of Kibale forest and has a variety of bird and primate species. Kibale is famous for its abundance of primates and some of the primates seen in the swamp included Red Colobus Monkeys, Red-tailed Monkey, Grey cheeked Mangabey, Vervet Monkey and Olive Baboon, among others.

Birds sighted included Black-headed Weaver, Red-eyed Dove, Great Blue Turaco, African Thrush, Bronze Mannikin, Yellow Wagtail, Common Bulbul, Common Waxbill, Black-necked Weaver, Hadada Ibis, Black-and-white Casqued Hornbill and Black-and-white Shrike Flycatcher. It was getting late so we headed back to the lodge for our overnight stay at Primates Lodge.

Day 13

Tuesday 22nd January

Travel to Entebbe

Today was a day to travel back to Entebbe. On our way we saw a number of bird species, such as Striped Kingfisher, Fan-tailed Widow Bird, Common Fiscal, Lizard Buzzard, Brown Snake Eagle and Open Billed Stork among others.

Finally, we reached Entebbe and checked in at 2 Friends Resort Beach Hotel where we had the use of rooms during the day. We had our last dinner and then later on headed to the Airport to catch our flight departing from Entebbe international Airport back to the UK via Nairobi, taking with us many memories of the wonderful wildlife of this beautiful country, not to mention numerous photographs to remind us of our holiday.
